Admissions applications for Autumn Term 2023

Children are admitted to the school in September of the year in which they have their fifth birthday. If there is anyone who wishes to apply for a place for September 2023 (d.o.b. 01.09.2018 - 31.08.2019) please obtain a Supplementary information form from the School Office. There is also a requirement to complete an online Local Authority application before January 15th 2023. This can be found at www.leics.gov.uk/admissions.

There will be an Open afternoon on October 5^{th} 1.30 – 4 p.m. for all prospective parents. Please inform any interested family and friends.

Attendance

Attendance will be a continued focus this year as we have a 97% target to achieve. This only allows up to 5 days of absence in the school year. A big thank you to the majority of parents/carers who make sure their children attend school regularly! You should be able to check your child's up-to-date attendance on Arbor from an email that was sent recently to log on to the system.

Breakfast club and Afterschool clubs

Thank you to everyone for their patience regarding the switchover from ParentPay to Arbor for booking into Breakfast and Afterschool club. I know there has been teething problems but this system allows us to allocate staff and buy food in advance and is a time efficient system once it gets going for parents and the office team. Booking for days in afterschool club will be closed 24 hours in advance.

Secondary school applications

Primary, Junior and Secondary headteachers are reminded to advise parents to apply for three schools and that for secondary admissions the national closing date is 31st October, and national offer date 1st March (or next working day). The majority of Year 6 children at St John Fisher would go to St. Paul's, or English Martyrs. Local secondary schools such as the ones in Wigston and Oadby have their own admission policies and it would be well worth consulting those.

Message from Leicestershire County Council on secondary school places

As the 2023 cohort will be larger still, the message to parents to express three options and include a catchment school is crucial. In some cases, those parents who have not done this may be allocated a school some distance away (with significant pressure on places, local schools may well be full with those who have applied within the deadline). Even if older siblings attend a secondary school or are in the feeder school, there is no guarantee of securing a place; parents need to have a Plan B in place. Please emphasise the importance of parents applying for three options and including a catchment school: leaving options blank will not increase their chance of gaining the preferred choice but does create a risk that no local place will be available.

Cross-country

Well done to all our runners from year 3, 4, 5, and 6 who competed in the first sporting competition of the academic year at Prestwold Hall. All performed magnificently – setting personal bests, showing determination, self-motivation and courage – in large and high quality fields. It was great to be back together again and the support of team SJF was equal to the running prowess – first class. For those who are interested in competing in races or getting fitter, there will be weekly cross country training for the next half term at least.

Parents evening

Thank you to everyone who responded to the parent questionnaire about parents' evening. Findings

- Most would prefer a hybrid approach a choice of in-person appointments or virtual appointments.
- More parents would prefer more in person booking slots than virtual booking slots.

As a result for this term, we will have a hybrid approach with the majority of bookings being in-person on Tuesday 11th October and on Thursday 13th October, all appointments will be virtual.
