Eco-committee report January 2023

After lots of hard work over the Advent term, we have finally completed our action plan for our Eco-schools Green flag award. The three topic areas we have chosen to work on are, Waste, Transport and Energy and we hope that with your support, we can make a difference to our world.

The first thing we are going to ask for your help with is cutting down on the amount of waste that goes to landfill. We have started collecting some hard-to-recycle things which will be collected from school by a local charity. We are collecting



toothbrushes and toothbrush packaging, toothpaste tubes, crisp wrappers, ink-jet cartridges and all sorts of pens, highlighters and board markers. The eco-committee will be helping to sort out the different materials ready for collection and helping to keep the school updated with progress.

In addition, we are also signed up for the Big Battery hunt. We are in competition with other schools across the country to collect as many batteries as possible and so far we have collected 840 batteries. We know of a school that has collected 7000 so we have a way to go!
