#### Term time homework

Children will be given basic homework activities (reading, phonics, maths fluency, limited online activities) over the term times e.g. half terms, Christmas/Easter/summer holidays. This is so that children can keep up or keep 'topped up' with learning and practice.

This will be made clear by the class teacher.

- science experiments

Year 6 may have obligatory homework in order for them to prepare and revise for their SATs examinations.

Parents have the option of taking the Christmas assessments home over the holidays too. All children took term assessments (Y2-5) recently. If you would like your child to bring these home over the holiday period, please contact the class teacher on dojo and the papers will be given to your children. Return all papers when finished with when we return to school. If we do not hear from you, we will not give the papers out.
