What the Platinum Mark recognises

- **Consistent high performance:** It demonstrates a school's sustained commitment and success over multiple years.
- **Commitment to competition:** It rewards schools for developing and nurturing competition, leadership, and sportsmanship.
- **Inclusivity:** A key component is ensuring a broad and balanced offer of sports and physical activity that engages all students, including those with disabilities or special educational needs (SEND).
- **Community impact:** It recognizes a school's positive impact on sports and activity both within the school and the wider community.
